Dear Parents

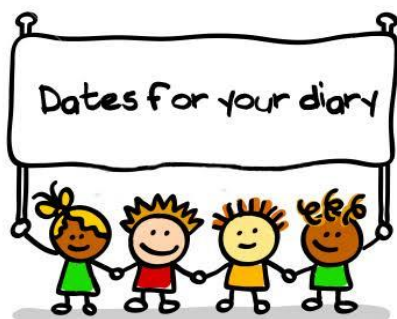
